Coding Accuracy Program (I-CAP) - A retrospective interval program that rewards provider's for assessing medical records & resubmitting claims with suspected/predicted chronic conditions.

Quality Pay For Performance (P4P) - Enhances quality of care by focusing on preventative & screening services and promotes engagement. Providers are incentivized for closing certain care gaps.

Notification of Pregnancy (NOP) - Incentive for timely submission of the NOP form; to identify high risk pregnancies, reduce number of preterm births & increase the number of healthier babies.

Continuity of Care (CoC) - Prospective rewards program based on provider outreach for assessing members for pre-existing or suspected chronic conditions via annual visits.
