





## **Improving Medication Adherence**

# In which Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) measures could improved medication adherence contribute to better outcomes?

- · Pharmacotherapy Management of COPD Exacerbation.
- · Asthma Medication Ratio.
- · Statin Therapy for Patients with Cardiovascular Disease.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Statin Therapy for Patients with Diabetes.
- Blood Pressure Control for Patients with Diabetes.
- · Anti-Depressant Medication Management.
- Adherence to Anti-Psychotic Medications for Patients with Schizophrenia.
- · High Blood Pressure Control.

### How can you enhance adherence strategies?

#### Communicate with each patient by using the appropriate:

- · Language preference and proficiency.
- · Health literacy levels.
- · Culturally relevant education materials.
- Address social determinants of health that may affect medication adherence, such as financial challenges or transportation obstacles.

#### Ask the right questions:

- Do you have all of the medications you were prescribed?
  (Probe for barriers such as cost or confusion)
- Do you understand why you are taking them?
- Do you ever forget to take your medications?
  (Discuss phone alarms, putting pills by the coffeemaker, etc.)
- · Do any of your medications make you sick?
- If you feel worse, do you stop taking them?
- · If you feel better, do you stop taking them?

## Schedule a 30-day follow-up appointment prior to the patient leaving the office.

#### Recommend tips for adherence improvement:

- · Encourage auto refills.
- · Pharmacy delivery options.
- · Pill boxes and/or daily phone reminders.
- · Place medications in visible area (by coffee pot, etc.)
- · Use the same pharmacy for all medications.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**



Nonadherence is associated with decreased health outcomes, including:

- · Higher rates of hospital admissions.
- · Poor quality of life.
- · Increased morbidity and mortality.
- · Increased health care costs.
