Recipe of the Month:

Slow Cooker Italian Soup Serves 10

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound ground turkey sausage
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/2 cup finely diced onion or 1 medium onion, finely diced
- 1 tablespoon minced garlic (from jar) or garlic powder
- 36 ounces chicken or vegetable stock
- 1 (16 oz) bag of Hy-Vee frozen cauliflower
- 2-3 cups Hy-Vee frozen chopped spinach
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup heavy cream

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Brown the ground turkey sausage in a skillet over medium heat until done
2. Using a slotted spoon, remove the sausage and place it into at least a 6-quart slow cooker. Discard remaining grease.
3. Please the oil in the same skillet and saute the onions for 3-4 minutes or until translucent.
4. Add the onions, chicken or vegetable stock, cauliflower florets, spinach, salt, and pepper to the slow cooker. Mix until combined.
5. Cook on high for 4 hours or on low for 8 hours.
6. Add the heavy cream and mix until combined. Enjoy!
Optional to sprinkle cheese on top for extra protein!

Interpreting Needs Translates to Better Care

Receiving a new prescription can already be overwhelming but it can be even more difficult when you can't read the label on your prescription. An Iowa Total Care member didn't speak English nor did anyone in their family.

Upon receiving their new prescription, a member contacted Iowa Total Care for assistance translating the label on their prescription. Iowa Total Care staff worked diligently with an interpreter to explain how to use the new inhaler and put the member's mind at ease.

But our staff didn't just stop there, they reached out to the pharmacy and suggested they use the same professional translation and interpretation resources as Iowa Total Care when printing non-English prescription labels and medication instructions.
