

# Un Burn Our Burn

## **Recipe of the Month:** Potato Soup Serves 4

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 3 medium potatoes,
- 4 cups reduced-sodium chicken broth,
- ½ cup chopped cooked ham,
- 1 cup nonfat dry milk powder,
- ½ cup chopped onion,
- ½ cup corn, canned or frozen





- 1. Wash potatoes and peel. Cut into 1-inch cubes; place in large pot.
- 2. Add broth to pan and bring to boil. Partially cover pot with lid and simmer 20 minutes or until potatoes are tender but not mushy.
- 3. Add ham, dry milk powder, onion and corn to the pot.
- 4. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 5 minutes.
- 5. Serve hot.

### Member Story: ITC Persistence Saved a Heart

An Iowa Total Care member needed help - and Iowa Total Care was there.

An Iowa Total Care member needed more time with a vital life vest that they rented, but Iowa Total Care didn't have approval for the member to use it that month on record. Iowa Total Care had received a previous authorization request, but it didn't include the current month, making the member's equipment approval not current.

The Iowa Total Care case manager on duty took this matter very seriously. The original authorization was tracked back to the hospital, where clinical notes led to the member's current healthcare provider.

The Iowa Total Care case manager contacted the provider and received approval for the life vest rental.

Passing these documents forward without approval would have resulted in a denial. Iowa Total Care recognized the urgent need and persisted in getting what was required for authorization.

During our 2023 Green to Go events, Iowa Total Care was able to serve the communities of Des Moines, Cedar Rapids, Sioux City and Corning.
