


TYPES OF WHEELCHAIRS

A MANUAL OR PUSH WHEELCHAIR IS USED WHEN A PERSON CAN USE THEIR HANDS AND ARMS. SOME PEOPLE USE THEM WHEN THEY HAVE AN INJURY SUCH AS A BROKEN LEG.

A SPORTS WHEELCHAIR SITS LOW TO THE GROUND AND MOVES FAST. IT IS USED TO PLAY BASKETBALL, TENNIS, RACING AND OTHER SPORTS.

> A MOTORIZED WHEELCHAIR CAN BE OPERATED WITH A JOYSTICK CONTROL INSTEAD OF PUSHING THE WHEELS TO MAKE IT GO GO AND STOP.

SOMETIMES A PERSON MAY USE MANY YPES OF WHEELCHAIRS FOR DIFFERENT SITUATIONS.









